



Fee Structure 2017-18

Dear Riding Member

The annual fees are now due for the 2017 to 2018 Financial Year. These fees must be paid no later than 15th June 2017 to ensure we comply with requirements from PCAV. If the fees are not paid Riders cannot participate at the July rally.

This year we are not issuing invoices. Members need to determine required payment based on schedules below.

Fees can be paid via direct deposit (**preferred method**). Please include the initial & family name so we can identify your payment and/or email confirmation to the club. Cash will be accepted at upcoming rallies.

**Subsequent Child applies to younger family Riding Member*

This fee includes the increased PCAV insurance fees, riders should visit the PCAV website to review these improved 24/7 insurance benefits which may include a discount on EFA insurance premiums.

The fees are based on PCAV fees including the Early Bird discount.

Fees paid after 20th of June 2017 will incur a \$5 late payment fee due to loss of discount.

Again we are offering the Alternative Associate Membership for those members over 17 as at the 1st July 2017.

The fees cover attendance at 2 rallies only. Additional rallies are \$30.

Advising of attendance & not attending on the day is considered an attendance.

All additional rallies must be paid for prior to attending the rally.

No refunds for non-attendance.

The Working Bee Levy has been adjusted to \$40, which will be refunded to member families attending a working bee (\$40 for 1 working bee). No levy for subsequent riders.

The Zone Levy is increased to \$40 (in line with the working bee levy) for compulsory attendance at designated Southern Metropolitan Zone events, as prescribed in the PCAV membership rules. The levy is not applied to Subsequent Riders. It is expected that members will be required to attend an event at least once a year as per a schedule to be prepared around August this year. A \$40 refund will be issued upon completing a Zone Duty.

The SMZ events scheduled this years fees are as follows;

1. Tooradin Horse Trials March 2018 - approximately 10 volunteers
2. Flat & Musical Games Day April 2018 - approximately 4 volunteers
3. Mini Tooradin May 2018 - approximately 10 volunteers

Members unable to attend SMZ duties as scheduled will be responsible for arranging a swap with another member. If the member is unable to complete their duties or arrange a swap another member may fill the duty & collect the refund.

MPPC Committee members are to be exempted from Zone duties & associated levy.

The Zone Levy may also be applied to other club specific commitments, such as Bunning's Sausage Sizzles or the like, at the discretion of the committee.

The committee are committed to ensure fees are kept to a realistic level. After payment of PCAV membership fees and \$80 reimbursable levy's the members can recover, the club retains \$285 per Junior member which works out to around \$26 per rally. In the past years total membership fees collected are less than the annual instructor's salaries for a year.

Online Membership and Registration for 2017/18

Dear Riding Member

The Pony Club Association of Victoria (PCAV) now requires all members to update their personal details online via the PCAV website. It is now **compulsory** that all members register or re-register via the website for 2017/18. Your membership logon is your key to Pony Club in 2017/18. No Rider will be eligible to ride in the July rally unless they have registered via the website.

The website is accessed via the PCAV website top left corner "OSM" "Members Login". Attached is a list of all club members ID, obviously we cannot provide Passwords but for riding members this information is on the front page of your card. Club Supporters (parents) can obtain passwords via the link.

It is recommended that when each Riding Member is updated on the database the Club Supporter should be updated at the same time.

When you first logon you will be asked to update existing details and to record additional information including horse and property details. Once you have updated these details, complete the registration form for 2017/18.

When completing the registration form it is very important that you select the payment option **cash** to avoid additional charges. PCAV can collect money on behalf of clubs but additional charges exist, hence by selecting the cash option and paying MPPC directly via direct deposit (**preferred method**) no additional fee will be incurred. Please include the initial & family name so we can identify your payment.

Cash will also be accepted at the May and June rally.
